


Asbestos awareness

The aim of this workshop is to provide participants with an 'awareness' of the different types of asbestos, its dangers and how to deal with it when found on sites to ensure that operatives remain safe from its potential dangers.



This workshop will enable participants to:

- Identify the main types of asbestos
- List some of the likely uses and locations of asbestos products in buildings
- List the diseases caused by exposure to asbestos
- Describe how to avoid the risks from asbestos
- Outline the general emergency procedure should asbestos be discovered or exposed on site
- Explain good practice in the disposal of asbestos waste





Who is the workshop for?

The workshop is provided as an introductory awareness session for both operatives and supervisors working on construction sites.

Duration: 2.5 – 3.5 hours – depending on numbers attending the session.
