Traffic Management

This one day course covers the key health and safety aspects to be considered when planning, documenting and implementing a traffic management system on a construction site.

Who for

Those with the responsibility for the design and implementation of a Traffic Management Plan.

Aim of the course

To ensure that those with the responsibility for safe traffic management arrangements on their construction sites have the knowledge and tools to be able to design, plan, document and implement the traffic management plan effectively

Objectives

On this course participants will:

- discuss the application of the Regulations regarding traffic management on site
- list their duties and responsibilities
- examine the requirement to have a defined safe system of work
- identify the risks associated with various items of plant and equipment
- explore the controls needed for the protection of the public
- draft a procedure for updating the traffic management plan to cope with changes on site
- apply the required standards of signage, lighting and barriers within the traffic control system
- produce a draft traffic management plan.

- Traffic management exercise - how to produce a traffic management plan
